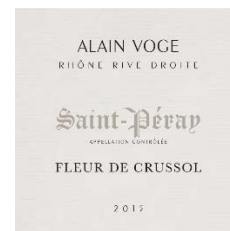




Domaine Alain Voge

AOC Saint-Péray - Fleur de Crussol

Our Saint-Péray “Fleur de Crussol” comes from our oldest MARSANNE vineyard (aged 70 years), in the heart of the original slopes of AOC SAINT PERAY, on granite soil slope with limestone elements.



POSITION

Locality named *La Côte*.

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TERROIR

These are the domain's oldest vines and at the age of 80 years old they are the oldest of this appellation; they are located in the site considered as being the origin of this appellation, above the village of Saint-Péray.

This slope of granite mixed with limestone colluvium is South-East facing. It looks towards Château de Crussol and the limestone mountain range of the same name.

OUR VINE GROWING AND WINEMAKING

The Marsanne vines are trained and pruned in the Gobelet style and supported by stakes. Winemaking is done using natural yeasts and only in 228-litre and 400-litre barrels, of which 30% are made of new wood.

The wine is matured on lees for a period of 16 months.

Annual production: 7,000 bottles

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THE WINE

Light straw color. Butterscotch, caramel, honey and white flowers.

Creamy and elegant.
