Grapes progressed to ideal ripeness as steady and warm days continued through July and August. Harvest wrapped, just in time for the first significant rains in October. We'll remember this vintage for stellar quality and

VINEYARDS:

Burnside Road Vineyard. We decided that if we ever made another Chardonnay, it would have to be among the best. Obviously, that means Russian River Valley. Also, "goldridge soils" which are like ancient dunes made of dark loam and gritty sand. The Balletto family grows these grapes only 10 miles from the Pacific Ocean, in-between Sebastopol and Bodega. This is about as cool climate as it gets! We love the grapes and the family.
