

Château Picourneau Malvezin AOP Haut-Médoc

- vineyard created in 1771
- First vintage of new owner: 2013
- Boutique estate : 5 acres
- Sustainable viticulture.
- On a clay-limestone subsoil, a sandy-gravelly soil with a thickness varying between 30 and 60 centimeters supports the growing of vines and the development of quality red wines.
- Merlot, (75%) which brings roundness and fruitiness
- Cabernet-Sauvignon (25%) of delayed maturity that gives the wine its power, its tannic structure and ageing potential.
- Little yield 36 hl/ha in 2013
- Hand harvest/ oak ageing.
