



90-92 Domaine Alain Voige **Saint-Péray Fleur de Crussol 2016**

Always among the top Saint Pérays, the 2016 Saint Peray Fleur de Crussol still has a ways to go in barrel before bottling (normally after around 17 months). Right now, the oak sticks out a bit in the form of baking spices and tannins, but I expect that will integrate with additional aging. Honey, nutmeg and anise on the nose are joined by cinnamon and pear on the full-bodied palate, which finishes long and slightly astringent.
