The 2014 Pinot Noir Domaine Lois Louise is one of the more nervous, energetic wines in the range. Sweet red cherry, blood orange, cinnamon, iron, spice and cedar give the 2014 a good bit of aromatic lift and brightness that really distinguishes it in this range. I would cellar the 2014 for another 6-12 months at a minimum to let it come together more fully in bottle.
