MIS EN BOUTEILLE AU CHATEAU

Ownership & history:

Chateau Yveline and Chateau les Chapelles have been in the Durand family for over 2 centuries. Yveline was named after two children from the family: Yves and Jacqueline

Today, Christian is in charge of the estate. He graduated in Oenology at the Bordeaux university.

His quest is to produce high quality wines mixing tradition and modernity.

Vineyard & location:

Chateau Yveline and Chateau les Chapelles are located near the town on Neac, on the right bank of the Garonne river.

The 3-hectare estate lies at the edge of Lalande de Pomerol AOC, Pomerol AOC and Montagne Saint Emilion AOC.

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

Harvest is carried out by hand, and the grapes are sorted twice: first in the vineyard, then again at the winery with a sorting table. Christian Durand does a traditional Bordeaux vinification in a mix of Stainless steel and concrete vats.

Very little oak influence in this blend, Christian's priority is the expression of the fruit.

Tasting:

The blend of the 3 grapes brings a exceptional aromatic complexy.

The structure of the Cabernet and the malbec is balanced by smooth and elegant Merlot. A very classic and traditional Bordeaux wine from this 3-hectare boutique estate.
