

CHATEAU JARON ROSE BORDEAUX Rosé (Dry rosé)



Ownership & history:

The vineyard is run in family for over 4 generations. Today Philippe Liberatore and his wife took over from the estate. Concerned with biodiversity, they are involved in an environmental approach in order to protect today's and tomorrow's world.

Vineyard & location:

This estate covers 30 hectares. The vineyards are planted in the far east of Bordeaux vineyard, a very qualitative soil. They produce AOC Bordeaux rouge, rosé, blanc and Bordeaux supérieur. The vines are on average 25 years old.

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

There are two ways of making rosé wine. One method, known as 'rosé de saignée', makes for fairly powerful wines, whereas the other method, direct pressing, results in more aromatic, refreshing wines. The rosé from Château Jaron is issued from the second method. Moreover the low temperature fermentation allow to keep all the fruit aromas.

Tasting:

On the nose there are notes of red currant and strawberry. In the mouth, the body is fresh and silky. It makes an excellent accompaniment to salads, barbecue or simply as in "apéritif".
