

# CHATEAU MOULIN DE CURAT

## PUISSEGUIN-SAINT-EMILION Rouge (Red)



### **Ownership & history:**

Château Moulin de Curat belongs to the Robin family, who can trace their roots in the region back to the seventeenth century.

### **Vineyard & location:**

The vines nestle on a hillside in the village of Puisseguin, in clayey limestone soil, only a few kilometers from the town of Saint Emilion itself.

### **Harvest, vinification & ageing:**

Sustainable farming (certified by Terra Vitis) is practised at the vineyard. The Family motto translate as "Quality before Quantity", and this dictum applies not least to the wine.

### **Tasting:**

Jean-François Robin's wines are authentic, balanced and tasty, with a delicate texture, soft tannins and attractive fruit aromas.

The "Puisseguin Saint Emilion" appellation offer elegant wines, similar to the "Saint-Emilion" reputed wines.

Food pairing : roasted duck and chicken, grilled beef or stew.
