Founded in 1923, Dom Brial brings together 200 winemakers in Baixas, a small French Catalan village whose history has been marked by a Benedictine monk, Dom Brial. His action influenced the winemakers who paid tribute to him by giving his name to his cellar.

Located near the Mediterranean, between the foothills of the Pyrenees and the Corbières, the Dom Brial vineyard covers nearly 2000 hectares certified in sustainable development and characterized by a mosaic of typical Roussillon soils, revealing a remarkable wine collection.






Roussillon: The Southern most vineyard area of France





The Southernmost vineyard of France

The southernmost vineyard of France, located in the Pyrenees-Orientales at the gateway to Spain, Roussillon is nestled between the Mediterranean and the mountains.




This amphitheater with a sunny climate offers a mosaic of terroirs for exceptional wines.

The Roussillon vineyard is exposed to a demanding climate: Mediterranean, with hot summers, mild autumns and winters and concentrated rainfall in autumn and spring.

The Southernmost vineyard of France

On the left bank of the Têt: granitic and gneissic arena soils, brown and black schists in the Agly valley, clay-limestone and limestone soils of the Corbières piedmont, stony terraces. On the right bank of the Têt: terraces mixed with yellow and red sandy clays.



Altitude between 100 and 400 meters is swept by the Tramontane, a dominant dry wind from the North which induces an exceptional sanitary state and allows to reduce phytosanitary treatments.

This selection of Vintage dates Rivesaltes are made using a process discovered in 1285 by Arnaud de Villeneuve, a Doctor at the Royal Court of the Kings of Majorca. Adding neutral winebased spirits to the grape must as it ferments, arrests fermentation and therefore preserves some residual sugar from the fruit that gives the wine its sweetness. The wines are aged in barrels or tuns for several years.
