Appellation: AOP Côtes du Roussillon Villages

Location : Baixas, Pyrénées Orientales – Roussillon, France

Grape Varieties: 80% Syrah, 20% Grenache Noir

Vine age: 20 years old

Vineyards: 4 hectares of clay and limestone hills, schist hills. Soil

is worked by using tractors, mating disruption

according to winegrowers in sustainable

development chart. Gobelt pruning. Grapes are

harvested by hands.

Winemaking: Reception of the grapes in our Terroir cellar, selection

of the beries by optical sorting, cold pre-fermentation maceration, classical wine-making in stainless seel tank of 80 hl with recurrent pumping over, devatting and filling new barrels for malolactic fermentation,

then blending

Aging: 15 months in French oak barrels.

Dom Brial

Founded in 1923, Dom Brial brings together 200 winemakers in Baixas, a small French Catalan village whose history has been marked by a Benedictine monk, Dom Brial. His action influenced the winemakers who paid tribute to him by giving his name to his cellar. Located near the Mediterranean, between the foothills of the Pyrenees and the Corbières, the Dom Brial vineyard covers nearly 2000 hectares certified in sustainable development and characterized by a mosaic of typical Roussillon soils, revealing a remarkable wine collection.
