Grape Varieties	100% Muscat petits grains
Vine age	20 years old
Vineyards	<i>Hautes Terrasses</i> : rolled stones terraces of clay soils <i>Terres Rouges</i> : clay and limestone hills of medium altitude <i>Arènes</i> : low-altitude limestone and sandy terraces, deep soils The vines are wired and in Cordon de Royat pruning. The disbudding is then carried out. Grapes are harvested with machine.
Winemaking	Reception of the grapes in our white wines cellar, direct pressing, cold settling, fermentation in traditional concrete vats at low temperature
Ageing	No ageing, bottling early winter

Dom Brial

Founded in 1923, Dom Brial brings together 200 winemakers in Baixas, a small French Catalan village whose history has been marked by a Benedictine monk, Dom Brial. His action influenced the winemakers who paid tribute to him by giving his name to his cellar. Located near the Mediterranean, between the foothills of the Pyrenees and the Corbières, the Dom Brial vineyard covers nearly 2000 hectares certified in sustainable development and characterized by a mosaic of typical Roussillon soils, revealing a remarkable wine collection.
