Château Prieuré Jehanne AOC SAINT ESTEPHE 2018

Château Prieuré Jehanne belongs to the Sourice family. They have been in the wine business for many generations with vineyards in the Medoc, Haut Medoc and also vineyards in the Loire valley.

A couple of years ago, Mr Sourice had the opportunity to buy a small parcel of one hectare in the AOC ST Estephe.

This boutique estate produces around 6000 bottles per vintage and is located near the village of PEZ renowned for producing excellent value St Estephe.

The vineyard is planted with old cabernet sauvignon vines bringing the structure and the complexity to the wine and young merlot vines bringing ripe fruit aromas to the blend.

Mr Sourice decided to name this chateau after is younger daughter Jehanne

Château Prieuré Jehanne is the result of a selection of the best grapes varieties of St Estephe vineyard.

It is generous, not too powerful, with a delicate vanilla and dark fruits bouquet. Best to drink tempered (around 18°C), as an accompaniment to meat dishes (white meat, red meat or game) or with cheese.
