BORDEAUX Rosé (Rosé)



Ownership & history:

Château Piconat has been in the Comin family for five generations. In 2003, the estate was entrusted to one of the daughters of the family, Isabelle. She took charge of the domain with the able assistance of her husband, Christophe Guicheney; Isabelle deals with the business side of things and Christophe makes the wine. Under their stewardship, Château Piconat has grown to 50 hectares in size.

Vineyard & location:

The château itself is in Soussac in the Entre-deux-Mers region, although the vines also spread across two neighbouring villages. The soil is made up of clay and limestone, which is typical for Bordeaux and has helped to make it one of the world's most famous winemaking areas.

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

Chateau Piconat Rosé comes from plots of young vines on the property. Grapes are harvested at the very beginning of maturity to favor fresh fruit. Rosé wine from a very gentle direct pressing with an ultra-short maceration time in the press. Vinification is made at low temperature like a white wine to preserve the maximum of aromas.

Tasting:

This Rose has an elegant raspberry color. Fresh on the nose with strawberry aromas. It's fruity and smooth on the palate ending with a fresh, gourmet finish.
