

CHATEAU JARON

BORDEAUX White



Ownership & history:

This vineyard has been run by the family for more than 4 generations. Today Phillipe Liberatore and his wife have taken over the estate. Concerned by biodiversity, they are involved in an environmental-friendly approach.

Vineyard & location:

The vineyard currently covers 30 hectares. The vineyards are planted in the far east of Bordeaux vineyard, a very qualitative terroir. They produce AOC Bordeaux rouge, rosé, blanc and Bordeaux supérieur. The vines are on average 25 years old.

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

Some notable aspects of the winemaking at Jaron are as follows:

- The use of sorting tables at the winery
- The use of temperature-controlled vats
- Micro-oxygenation of the wine, which really brings out the fruit flavours and rounds off the tannins
- Jaron is aged partially in stainless steel but the best parcels are aged in clay amphorae for twelve months.

Tasting:

The colour is pale yellow with green reflections. The nose presents notes of grapefruit, lemon and white flesh fruits. The palate is lively, fruity and has a very nice acidic balance. Perfect accompaniment to aperitifs, salads, risottos and cheeses.
