

CHATEAU PEY MARTIN MEDOC Rouge



Ownership & history:

Château Pey Martin has belonged to the Francisco family since 1870, and it is with passion and respect for tradition that Stéphanie Francisco and her father Jean produce a typically Médoc wine cradled by the two winds of the Gironde estuary.

Vineyard & location:

Château Pey Martin is located in the picturesque village of Plautignan, in the heart of the Médoc, between the Garonne and the Atlantic Ocean. The soil is a mixture of gravel and clayey limestone which allows us to obtain wines of great finesse.

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

This high quality Médoc is harvested by hand after rigorous sorting. The vinification is carried out in the traditional way in stainless steel vats.

The wine is aged partly in oak barrels and partly in concrete vats.

Tasting:

The aromas are elegant and complex, with notes of blackcurrant, liquorice and roasting. The palate is concentrated and the tannins are smooth and velvety. The slightly roasted finish adds a lot of charm.

Château Pey-Martin is a perfect match for grilled beef or traditional French or Italian dishes.
