PUISSEGUIN-SAINT-EMILION



Property & History:

The Pascal family bought this small estate in 2009. Chateau Lafaurie is now run by Alain Pascal and his son Romain.

Vineyard & Location:

Chateau Lafaurie is a small family property of 5 hectares located in Puisseguin, near the well-known village of Saint Emilion. The average age of the vines is 30 years.

Harvest, Vinification & Ageing:

Grape juice is macerated and fermented in stainless steel vats in order to preserve the primary aromas of fruits. The wine is ageing in oak barrels during 12 months.

Tasting :

The high proportion of the Merlot grape variety in the blend gives fruity notes expression like cherry in particular. The ageing in oak barrels brings spicy notes as well as roundness on the palate.
