

CHATEAU LA PLAIGE BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR Rouge (Red)



Ownership & history:

Château La Plaige has been in the Naud family for 5 generations. Since 2000, Frédéric Naud and his wife Lise have been managing the vineyard with passion and respect for the family's winemaking tradition.

Vineyard & location:

The estate sits on a hillside overlooking the Dordogne river on the eastern edge of the Bordeaux appellation. The combination of clay and limestone soils allows the owner Frédéric Naud to offer a wine that is both powerful and elegant.

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

The traditional Bordeaux vinification is carried out in stainless steel vats, allowing the pure and primary aromas of the fruit to be preserved and the temperature to be controlled to obtain a quality product. The wine is then aged for 18 months in concrete vats before bottling. This allows the tannins to soften slightly, to melt and harmonise with the fruit.

Tasting:

The nose has aromas of wild berries and notes of crushed strawberries. The palate is rich, with racy tannins that are both dense and silky.

Château La Plaige is a perfect match for grilled beef, roast lamb, and any other dish with a generous flavour.
