

# CHATEAU PICONAT

## BORDEAUX Rouge (Red)



### Ownership & history:

Château Piconat has been in the Comin family for five generations. In 2003, the estate was entrusted to one of the daughters of the family, Isabelle. She took charge of the domain with the able assistance of her husband, Christophe Guicheney; Isabelle deals with the business side of things and Christophe makes the wine. Under their stewardship, Château Piconat has grown to 50 hectares in size.

### Vineyard & location:

The château itself is in Soussac in the Entre-deux-Mers region, although the vines also spread across two neighbouring villages. The soil is made up of clay and limestone, which is typical for Bordeaux and has helped to make it one of the world's most famous winemaking areas.

### Harvest, vinification & ageing:

There is a beautiful old winery at the estate that has been recently renovated. This means that the modern technology is in place to help out in a winemaking process that shows respect for traditional values.

### Tasting:

This cherry-coloured wine is very smooth on first taste, with persistent fruit notes and a strong sense of balance. The finish shows silky, molten tannins. Château Piconat makes an excellent accompaniment to French charcuterie, grilled meats or hard cheeses.
