

CHATEAU LA ROSE GACHET

LALANDE DE POMEROL Rouge (Red)



Ownership & history:

Two pretty turrets and an elegant gate mark the entrance to this distinguished 12-hectare estate (3.5 hectares in Lalande de Pomerol and 8.5 in the Montagne Saint Emilion appellation). Its renowned producer has earned a reputation for crafting exceptional quality wines, reflecting an ancestral tradition combined with refined modernity. Each bottle of Château La Rose Gachet tells the story of its terroir and embodies the elegance and finesse that defines the great Bordeaux wines. The château's vines are passionately pampered by a team of dedicated winegrowers, a commitment that is unmistakably reflected in every sip.

Vineyard & location:

Libourne enjoys a temperate oceanic climate, both mild and humid. This allows for controlled ripening of the grapes. The soil consists of gravel and clay, with a significant presence of limestone. The vineyard is located on the right bank of the Garonne in the commune of Néac

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

Traditional vinification with meticulous grape selection and plot-by-plot fermentation. A light oak treatment is used during aging to enhance complexity and softness. Average age of the vines: 50 years. A classic thermoregulated concrete vat room stands adjacent to a beautiful 18th century Gironde charterhouse.

Tasting:

Beautiful ruby color. Intense nose, with aromas of ripe red fruits. The attack is crisp with flavors of jammy red berries. The tannic structure is harmonious with rich and well-integrated tannins. The mouth is silky while the subtle oak influence adds aromatic complexity. This is a classic Lalande de Pomerol, distinguished by its elegant texture and promising balance.
