Ownership & history:

The Meynaud family owns Château Franc Couplet on Bordeaux's Right Bank. Following the completion of his studies, Éric Meynaud assumed management of the family estate in 1995 and has since led its significant expansion, increasing the vineyard area from 10 hectares to more than 100 hectares. Driven by a constant pursuit of quality, Éric Meynaud focuses on maximizing the vineyard's potential, an approach that has earned the wines numerous awards in France and strong recognition among professionals and wine enthusiasts worldwide.

Vineyard & location:

Château Franc Couplet is located in the Entre-Deux-Mers appellation, on the eastern edge of Bordeaux, on a limestone-clay terroir recognized for its high natural quality and suitability for viticulture.

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

This Limited Edition is a unique selection drawn from the 20 finest oak barrels, representing a production of 6,200 bottles. Following traditional Bordeaux vinification, the wine is matured in French oak barrels for 12 months.

Tasting:

A large variety of fruits appear on the nose: The nose reveals an expressive aromatic profile with notes of raspberry, cherry, and plum. On the palate, the wine is well-balanced with refined, well-integrated tannins. Oak ageing brings additional smoothness and contributes subtle hints of spice and coffee, enhancing the wine's overall complexity.
