BORDEAUX Rouge

Ownership & history:

The vineyard has been family-owned for over four generations and is now managed by Philippe Liberatore and his wife, Caroline. With a strong commitment to biodiversity, they implement environmentally responsible practices aimed at preserving the vineyard's natural balance and long-term sustainability.

Vineyard & location:

The estate covers 30 hectares, located in the eastern part of the Entre-Deux-Mers area, on the far eastern edge of the Bordeaux vineyard, where soils are recognized for their quality.

This Cabernet Franc cuvée comes from a single 3-hectare parcel within the estate. The vines have an average age of 25 years..

Harvest, vinification & ageing:

Winemaking at Jaron combines precision and modern techniques, including sorting tables and temperature-controlled vats. Micro-oxygenation enhances fruit expression and refines tannin structure.

The wine is mainly aged in stainless steel tanks, with the finest parcels matured in clay amphorae for approximately 10 months, adding texture and complexity while preserving aromatic purity.

Tasting:

This medium-bodied Cabernet Franc displays an elegant profile with vibrant strawberry and red plum aromas, enhanced by subtle earthy notes. The palate is fresh and balanced, with crisp acidity and a fruity finish, making it an excellent match for vegetable dishes, quiches or gourmet burgers
